Pol Roger Brut Reserve NV, France v (1)

- Btl 64.95 -

Firm and elegant with good, balanced, natural acidity which improves with ageing.

Bollinger Special Cuvée NV, France (3)

- Btl 69.95 -

Full-bodied style, resulting from the large amount of Pinot Noir in the blend.

Laurent Perrier Rosé NV, France v (2)

- Btl 89.95 -

100% Pinot Noir. Glorious pink colour with rounded red fruit flavours.

Dom Perignon Vintage 2010, France ve (1)

- Btl 195.95 -

The nose is honeyed; intense and rounded flavours, pure, mineral and fruits.

Sauternes Dulong 2017, France (8)

- 50^{cl} Btl ??? -

A unique richness mixed with the subtle combination of citrus, fruits, spices, white flowers and honey.

Tokaji Classic Late Harvest 2009, Hungary (8)

- 50^{cl} Btl ??? -

Light and less intensely sweet wine with lovely notes of dried tropical fruit, peach, citrus blossom, spices and marmalade.

Domaine Bacheys-Legros Saint-Aubin 1er Cru Les Champlots 2016, France *v* (2)

- Btl 59.95 -

Rich, balanced, buttery fruit, finishing with a hint of lime.

Chablis 1er Cru Louis Latour 2018, France *v* (2)

- Btl 67.95 -

Only the best grapes from Premier Cru appellations are used to ensure excellent fruit on the nose and the palate with a long mineral and steel finish.

Chartron et Trébuchet Meursault 2018, France (3)

- Btl 76.95 -

Flavours of honeysuckle, fern, candied lemon, brioche and toasted bread form the bouquet, with some notes of almond paste and hazelnuts, and a crisp finish.

Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru Morgeot Bacheys-Legros 2017, France *v* (2)

- Btl 84.95 -

A superb example of classic Burgundy. Flowery aromas with hints of lemon and pear with subtle toast. Great depth and minerals with a balanced long finish.

Puligny-Montrachet Bouchard Père et Fils 2018, France (2)

- Btl 94.95 -

Delicious floral and fruit aromas with a nice oaky note on the nose. An attractive marriage between power and elegance, with lovely smoothness.

Amarone Della Valpolicella, Famiglia Pasqua 2016, Italy *ve* (D)

- Btl 56.95 -

Expansive bouquet with fresh scents of blackberries and spicy tones with sweetish vanilla-like notes. Warm and well-balanced with gentle tannins.

Château Siran Margaux 2012, France (D)

- Btl 59.95 -

Notes of red plum, raspberry, mineral and cedar on the nose. Medium-bodied with fine, gently tannin, and graphite-tinged black fruits that turns spicier towards the finish.

Brunello di Montalcino Tenuta di Argiano 2014, Italy (E)

- Btl 63.95 -

Classic characters of sweet toasty oak and earthy fruit that Sangiovese typically produces. Complex and ripe tannic structure.

Gevrey-Chambertin 'En Champs' Philippe Livera 2016, France *v* (B)

- Btl 79.95 -

Aromas of black pepper, red berries and liquorice, with medium tannins.

Château Vray Croix de Gay Pomerol 2007, France (B)

- Btl 84.95 -

A refined Pomerol with good depth of blackberry and dark raspberry fruit. Smooth with excellent precision and mouth watering acidity.

Vosne-Romanée Michel Gros 2015, France (C)

- Btl 118.95 -

Deep colour and a bright perfumed nose are followed by black cherries, spiciness and a satin-like texture.
